NAIL CAN HILL TRAILS

Nail Can Hill is part of the regional Crown reserve west of Albury's city centre. An area of extensive undulating bushland, the network of trails is used for bushwalking, running and mountain bike riding. Nail Can Hill is also home to Albury's famous Nail Can Hill Run – a popular 11.3 kilometre event that has been held in May each year since 1977.

HUME AND HOVELL TRACK












The Hume and Hovell Track is a 426 kilometre trail that traverses the rugged and beautiful countryside from Yass to Albury. Using a mix of public roads, fire trails and purpose-built single tracks, the trail follows the general direction that the European explorers Hamilton Hume and William Hovell took on their expedition to Port Phillip in 1824.
